Dear Friends!

I am writing this letter to introduce you to our “Cultura Stella Nova” concept and to describe its content, potential and to explain in a little detail some of the associated activities.

In the belief that Culture and cultural development is an essential component of a healthy society and that this process is heightened and defined refined by including artists coming from diverse cultural backgrounds.

Our goal is to build a base for barrier free cultural activities related to inclusion, and to form bridges between our village community and the local population especially close neighbours in the greater village of Breitenfurt as well as the surrounding population in Lower Austria and Vienna.

Dorfgemeinschaft Breitenfurt

The “Dorfgemeinschaft Breitenfurt” is situated in Lower Austria, bordering the suburban district of 1230 Vienna. The village of Breitenfurt lies approximately 15 kilometres west of the city centre in a scenic area of the Vienna woods. The guiding principle and focus of this facility is to concentrate on the healthy core of every disabled person and to nurture their intrinsic being and personality.

This is the barometer of all our efforts and the basis for further development of character, sense of community and improvement of skills.

Guided by the conviction that the dignity of the disabled human being is inviolable and that everyone has the right to develop their own personality in freedom, we continuously search for individual potential so that our residents in need of special care, are guided to towards independence and a self-sufficient existence.

Cultura Stella Nova

Mainly through cultural activities, “Cultura Stella Nova” of “Dorfgemeinschaft Breitenfurt” aims to become a socially interactive, inclusive and cultural space that has the facility to present an opportunity for enriching experiences on diverse levels for all those involved and included.

To this end, it is our concern to provide invigorating spaces that can offer diverse learning experiences so that a special quality and feeling of life may develop.

We have the following venues at our disposal:

Cafe Pueblo:

Cafe Pueblo is a Coffee house with tables and seating for 40 people. It contains a coffee- machine and dishwasher as well as enough crockery and cutlery to cater for all who can be seated. Aesthetically it is a pleasing space containing plants, greenery and natural products. It is decorated in an attractive and restful colour scheme with thoughtful lighting arranged in a manner conducive to comfort, contentment and joy. The concept envisages this space being used by disabled residents, co-workers and staff for mid-day meals, comfortable coffee breaks in the afternoon and generally a meeting venue with a relaxed atmosphere for evening and weekend events.

Stella Nova Saal

As I have already stated, “Art and Culture” form an important component of daily life through concerts, readings, drama and exhibitions. These events cater for, not only members of the “Dorfgemeinschaft Breitenfurt” but also close neighbours and residents of surrounding communities, villages and districts. This is one of the strategies used to promote the integration of “Dorfgemeinschaft” and the surrounding population and vice versa.

Stella Nova Saal is a multifunctional hall with capacity of approximately 130 seats and is equipped with modern lighting and sound technologies.

I hope that I have sparked your interest for this initiative and look forward to hearing your views.
